NCIC Announces Creation of Clerk's Office and Rollout of New Electronic Filing System

Raleigh, N.C. – The North Carolina Industrial Commission announces the formation of a Clerk's Office to streamline and simplify the filing of documents with the Commission and the appointment of Emily Baucom as Clerk of the Industrial Commission. The creation of the Clerk's Office coincides with the adoption of new Industrial Commission rules that mandate the electronic filing of all documents as of February 1, 2016.

In a move designed to both simplify the filing process for Commission customers and improve the integrity of the Industrial Commission's electronic files, the Commission created the Clerk's office to oversee the eventual adoption of universal filing through the Commission's electronic document filing portal (EDFP). The new rules in effect on February 1st provide for mandatory use of EDFP for the filing of certain documents and email filing of all other documents.
