Within 21 days of the date of this Order, the Defendant or the Defendant's counsel shall file a stipulation as to the mediator or notice

of the parties' failure to agree on a mediator on IC Form MSC 4. See Rule 11 NCAC 23G.0102.

The parties and a mediator selected by agreement shall agree upon the mediator's rate of compensation. A mediator appointed by the Commission will be compensated at the rate of \$150 per hour for time spent in the mediated settlement conference, to be billed in quarter hour segments, in addition to a \$150 administrative fee, in accordance with Rule 11 NCAC 23G.0107.

All parties, their attorneys and individuals with authority to settle the claim shall attend, as set forth in Rule 11 NCAC 23G.0104(a).

The parties shall exchange all medical and rehabilitation records available to the parties related to the injury in question and any recorded statements, expert opinions, reports and other documents, tapes and photographs that are relevant or material to the issues in controversy at least 15 days prior to mediation.

This case will be set for hearing on the next available calendar to be heard in due course unless sooner settled by mediation.
