An exception may be made for unexpected emergencies, in which case the continuance request should be filed as described above and followed up with a telephone call or electronic mail to the law clerk identified below. **In the event a case is continued, the case will be heard before the same panel at a later date.** In lieu of a continuance, oral argument may be waived for the party requesting the continuance.
