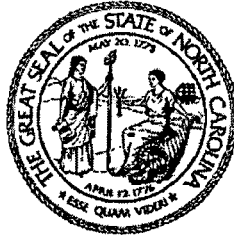




MINUTES


Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. §§ 97-25 and 97-81(a) and in order to keep the Industrial Commission's medical mileage reimbursement rate as reflective of actual cost as possible, **the Industrial Commission hereby adopts** as the mileage reimbursement for medical travel the same amount per mile as is in effect for mileage rates for use of a car for business purposes as set by the Internal Revenue Service. For calendar year 2009, that rate is 55 cents per mile.

The Industrial Commission further adopts as the mileage reimbursement for medical travel any future changes in the amount per mile in effect for mileage rates for use of a car for business purposes set by the Internal Revenue Service. Thus, the Industrial Commission's mileage reimbursement rate shall in future be automatically adjusted to reflect any changes in the business mileage rate set by the Internal Revenue Service. The Industrial Commission's Form 25T *Itemized Statement of Charges for Travel* shall be revised as needed to reflect the linkage between the IRS business mileage rate and the NCIC medical mileage rate and to provide the current rate for those using the form. This policy of automatic adjustment shall remain in place until further notice from the Industrial Commission.




