Requests for continuances should be submitted at least two weeks prior to the date of hearing. An exception may be made for unexpected emergencies, in which case the continuance request should be filed as described above and followed up with a telephone call or electronic mail to the law clerk identified below. **In the event a case is continued, the case will be heard before the same panel at a later date.** In lieu of a continuance, oral argument may be waived for the party requesting the continuance.
