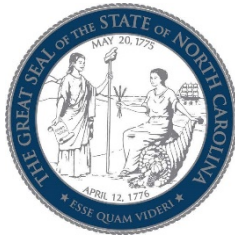

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL PARTIES

The cases listed on the attached calendar are scheduled for disposition by the Full Commission. Pursuant to the Full Commission's current hearing policy, some of the cases will be heard remotely via videoconference, and some will be heard in-person. The cases that will be heard remotely are designated as "REMOTE" and indicate only the date of the hearing. You will receive an email with instructions for videoconference participation at a later date that includes the time of the hearing. Some cases may be determined without oral argument pursuant to Rule 11 NCAC 23A .0701(h) or Rule 11 NCAC 23B .0301. The parties will be notified by the Commission prior to the hearing dates below if oral argument is waived. If no such notification is provided, oral argument will be held as scheduled below:

If your hearing will be held in-person, please enter the Dobbs building through the security desk area located on the third floor (on the mall area). You will be required to present a photo ID in order to enter the building.

Please review the enclosed calendar to determine the exact date on which your case will be heard. The hearing time may change based on the number of cases scheduled on the hearing day. **If you are not present in court (or on the videoconference) when your case is reached, the Full Commission will consider the record and will render its decision without hearing oral argument.**

For cases appearing on the enclosed calendar, all motions, including requests for continuances, should be addressed to the chair of the panel and must be filed in accordance with Rule 11 NCAC 23A .0108 for workers' compensation cases, or Rule 11 NCAC 23B .0104 for tort cases. Requests for continuances should be submitted at least two weeks prior to the date of hearing. An exception may be made for unexpected emergencies, in which case the continuance request should be filed as described above. **In the event a case is continued, the case will be heard before the same panel at a later date.** In lieu of a continuance, oral argument may be waived for the party requesting the continuance.

ALL BRIEFS AND FORMS 44 must be filed in accordance with Rule 11 NCAC 23A .0108 for workers' compensation cases or Rule 11 NCAC 23B .0104 for tort cases.
