ADOPTION OF RELEVANT PORTIONS OF THE NORTH CAROLINA CODE OF JUDICIAL CONDUCT


The Industrial Commission hereby adopts as standards of conduct for Commissioners and Deputy Commissioners Canons 1, 2, and 3 of the North Carolina Code of Judicial Conduct, as amended January 31, 2006. Canons 4, 5, 6, and 7, dealing with a judge's participation in cultural, historical, political and extra-judicial activities and financial reporting requirements, are either inapplicable to the non-elected positions or are currently regulated by the North Carolina Ethics Commission.




