If both parties agree to the extension of time, there will be no need to submit a formal Motion and proposed Order to the Commission; however, the parties must inform the Commission, in writing, as to the extension of time agreed upon. Any party who fails to timely file a brief may not be allowed oral argument before the Full Commission.
