For cases appearing on the enclosed calendar, all motions, including requests for continuances, should be addressed to the chair of the panel and must be filed in accordance with Rule 11 NCAC 23A .0108 for workers' compensation cases, or Rule 11 NCAC 23B .0104 for tort cases. Requests for continuances should be submitted at least two weeks prior to the date of hearing. An exception may be made for unexpected emergencies, in which case the continuance request should be filed as described above and followed up with a telephone call or electronic mail to the Counsel identified below. **In the event a case is continued, the case will be heard before the same panel at a later date.** In lieu of a continuance, oral argument may be waived for the party requesting the continuance.
