

LIFE SAVING AWARD

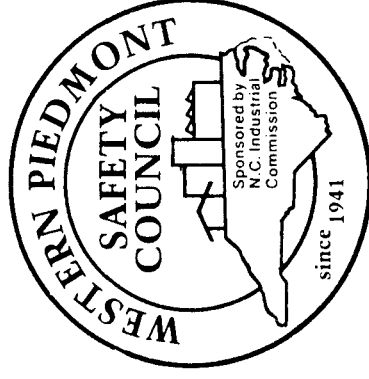

Western Piedmont Safety Council organized in 1941, has developed an ongoing program to help in the reduction in the loss of North Carolina's vital human and economic resources.

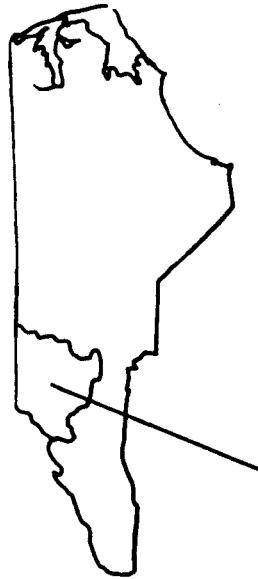


The **Western Piedmont Safety Council** is sponsored by the Industrial Commission Safety Department, a Division of the North Carolina Department of Commerce.

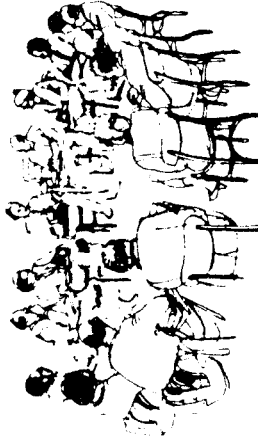
COUNCIL AREA
