Dr. Bunn joined Navistar International Transportation Corporation as Corporate Medical Director in November, 1995. Before coming to Navistar, Dr. Bunn served as an Assistant Professor and Director of Research for Occupational and Environmental Medicine and Internal Medicine at Duke University Medical Center, Senior Director for Occupational Health and Environmental Affairs for the Pharmaceutical Research and Development Division of Bristol Myers, Corporate Medical Director, Senior Director of Health & Safety and Environment for Manville Corporation, and International Medical Director for Mobil Corporation. Dr. Bunn has also received faculty appointments at Yale University School of Medicine, University of Colorado Schools of Pharmacy and Medicine, University of Cincinnati School of Medicine and Northwestern University Medical Center. He is co-author of four books and an author of over one hundred scientific publications. Dr. Bunn has served on over twenty scientific boards including the Science Advisory Board of the Environmental Protection Agency and committees of the World Health Organization, and National Academy of Sciences. Dr. Bunn serves on the editorial boards of several scientific journals including Occupational Medicine and Occupational and Environmental Medicine.
