In 1975, he returned to the AFL-CIO as a specialist on Asian affairs. He was appointed to his current position, in charge of workers' compensation issues, in April 1984.

Ellenberger is a member of the Labor Research Advisory Council to the U.S. Department of Labor and the National Academy of Social Insurance. He serves as co-chair of the Labor Management Discussion Group on Workers' Compensation and is a Certified Employee Benefit Specialist (CEBS).

Ellenberger is a graduate of San Francisco State University. He is a member of Local 35 of The Newspaper Guild, the American Council on Germany, and Vietnam Veterans of America. He has written on a variety of subjects, including articles on German co-determination, Japanese management, international trade union organizations and social insurance issues.
