## Mediation Attendance Requirements for Industrial Commission Cases

The Industrial Commission permanently amended Rule 11 NCAC 23G .0104 in 2023 to better align the mediation attendance requirements for Industrial Commission cases with the mediation attendance requirements for Superior Court division cases, which are found in Rule 4 of the Rules for Mediated Settlement Conferences and Other Settlement Procedures in Superior Court Civil Actions.

## Rule 11 NCAC 23G .0104(b) states, in relevant part:

... The attendance method for Industrial Commission mediations shall be the same as the attendance method set forth in Rule 4 of the Rules for Mediated Settlement Conferences and Other Settlement Procedures in Superior Court Civil Actions, which is hereby incorporated by reference and includes subsequent amendments and editions.
