Harry Phillips, CPO, began his career in 1977 as a prosthetic and orthotic technician with Dankmeyer, Inc. in Baltimore, Maryland. Dankmeyer is a large general Prosthetics and Orthotics practice, with offices throughout the state of Maryland. In 1981, Phillips returned to New York University Postgraduate Medical School for certificate courses in Orthotics and Prosthetics leading to Certification in Prosthetics in 1983 and Orthotics in 1984.

Phillips pursued a general practice with Dankmeyer, Inc. During his time with Dankmeyer, he participated in the Johns Hopkins Prosthetic Clinic, and was a charter member of the Union Memorial Prosthetic Clinic and The Chesapeake Hand Center Upper Extremity Prosthetic Clinic. He also was responsible for the Easton, Maryland office of Dankmeyer, Inc.

In December of 1997, to pursue an interest in improving the quality and scope of his Orthotic practice, Harry Phillips joined the Duke University Medical Center as a Staff Orthotist in the Duke Orthotics and Prosthetics Department. At Duke, he was responsible for providing Orthotic services to the Adult Acute Rehabilitation Department, while it was in Duke South, and the Myelodysplasia Clinic at Lenox Baker Hospital, in addition to management of an outpatient case load.

In June of 2001, Phillips joined Triangle Orthopaedic Associates, P.A. to establish their Orthotics and Prosthetics Department. The Orthotics and Prosthetics Department provides a full range of orthotic and prosthetics services both to Triangle Orthopaedic's patients as well as referrals from the surrounding community.
