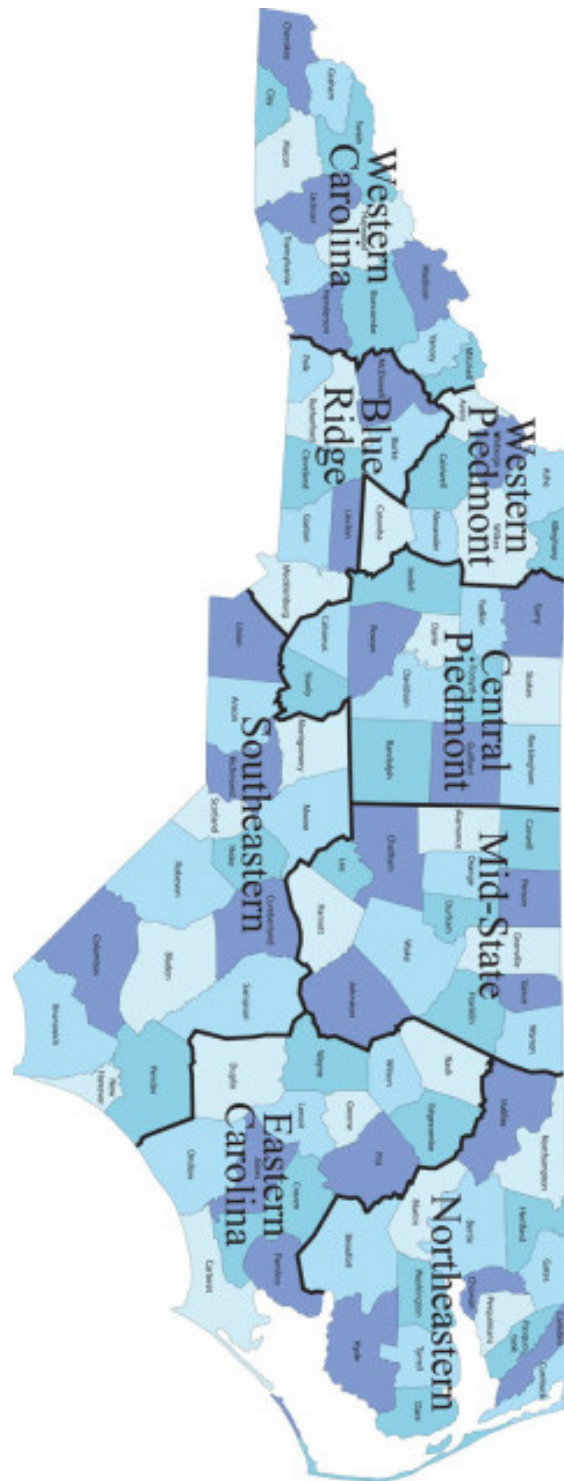
NORTH CAROLINA REGIONAL SAFETY COUNCILS

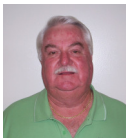

ACCIDENT PREVENTION AND SAFETY SERVICES

The accident prevention and safety & health services offered by the Safety Education Section of the North Carolina Industrial Commission are established to provide competent, practical instruction in accident prevention and workers' compensation. The courses and workshops are designed for the supervisor and employee in the interest of reducing accidents and their cost in North Carolina. Our schedule offers professional programs with experienced safety consultants from the Industrial Commission. **A Legislative mandated Fee Schedule is now in effect. (See Fee Schedule).** Programs are scheduled to meet the production needs of client companies. We request that as much lead time as possible be given for course scheduling. Classes vary from one hour to eight hours. Call your area Safety Consultant for more information and scheduling.

ACCIDENT PREVENTION CERTIFICATE AWARENESS PROGRAM (APCAP)

Directed at the supervisor and manager, the course places special emphasis on workers' compensation, accident prevention, work habits, and supervisory methods needed to reach a goal of accident and injury-free performance. The course covers the principles of investigation, basic questions to ask, and how to use the report to eliminate the causes of accidents. - **BASIC PROGRAM (30 HRS)**

COMPETENT PERSON SCAFFOLDING

Critical to scaffolding safety are the use of competent persons for the design, erection/dismantling, and maintenance of scaffolds, and trained workers for their use. **Please call Alvin Scott at 919-218-2792 for more information. (See Fee Schedule)**

FIRST AID AND CPR/AED COURSE

National Safety Council (NSC) First Aid and CPR Course is offered through the Industrial Commission. The eight-hour presentation is taught at the employer site. A NSC First Aid book is required for each student. The course is excellent first aid and CPR/AED training for employees with a clear, detailed text supplemented by visual aids. NSC First Aid and CPR/AED books must be ordered from the NSC at the time of scheduling through our safety consultant. NSC First Aid and CPR/AED Certificates are issued to those satisfactorily completing the course. **(See Fee Schedule)**

NSC DEFENSIVE DRIVING COURSE

The NSC Defensive Driving Course is a four-hour classroom course. The objectives of the course are to:

- ◆ Increase the participants' knowledge of defensive driving skills
- ◆ Motivate participants to take personal responsibility for their own driving behavior, and ultimately...
- ◆ **Change driving behavior!**

NSC Defensive Driving Course books must be ordered at the time of scheduling. Certificates will be issued to those successfully completing the course. HAZWOPER FIRST RESPONDER AWARENESS LEVEL AND OPERATIONS LEVEL TRAINING

This course prepares employees, who are likely to discover or witness a release of hazardous waste, to initiate a response procedure by notifying the proper authorities, also known as **First responder awareness level.** **Operations level training** is for those

individuals who respond to a release of hazardous substances by protecting nearby persons, property or the environment in a defensive manner. Operations level training consists of at least eight hours of training and demonstrated competency. FLAGGER CERTIFICATION

These requirements apply to anyone working inside the Right of Way of a NC DOT Highway System. To receive Flagger Certification training, call Mel Harmon @ 919-218-3374 to schedule a class. **Fee is \$25/person plus \$5 for book.**
