Tracey H. Weaver is a NCDRC Certified Superior Court Mediator. She has presented and written on the topic of mediation in workers' compensation claims for Continuing Legal Education seminars and the North Carolina Bar Association Workers' Compensation Section's *Course & Scope* newsletter. She serves on the North Carolina Bar Association Workers' Compensation Council as the chair of the Mediation Committee and is a member of the Dispute Resolution section.
