

MINUTES

In an effort to facilitate the payment of fines, fees, and sanctions, the Industrial Commission hereby adopts effective October 1, 2010, the following requirements regarding payment of fees, fines, and sanctions.

All fees, fines, and sanctions payable to the Industrial Commission shall be payable by cash, check, money order, credit card (VISA or Mastercard only), or Automated Clearinghouse (ACH) Transfer (e-check).

With regard to the payment of fees, fines, or sanctions by Automated Clearinghouse (ACH) Transfer, this form of payment is only available upon application to and approval by the Commission in accordance with the procedures for ACH Transfer payments promulgated by the Office of the State Controller for the State of North Carolina.

Documents or Forms filed with the Industrial Commission that require the payment of a processing fee must be accompanied by payment at the time of filing. Any document or form requiring the payment of a processing fee which is not accompanied by payment at the time of filing may be returned without processing.

These Minutes are applicable to all payments made to the Industrial Commission, whether in person, via U.S. mail, or through any electronic payment system used by the Commission.
